Please carpool, or use Uber, Lyft or the “Dwight Shuttle” to get to the Station Inn – parking is limited. Dwight is available to shuttle people to/from the Station Inn; his cell is 619-977-4700. First shuttle will leave Parking Lot A (near Laskey) at 6:30 pm.

If you are using Uber or Lyft, the street address of Scarritt-Bennett is 1008 19th Ave. South, but we suggest having the driver meet you in Scarritt-Bennett Parking Lot A, which is on 18th Ave. South, north of Edgehill and below Grand.

Easiest way to drive to the Station Inn: Turn right as you leave Laskey Parking Lot A, then left on Edgehill. Turn left on 12th Ave. South. You come to a traffic light in The Gulch and go left to stay on 12th Ave. Nearby restaurants also have valet parking – this is the recommended method for parking; or there is a public lot about one block away (you’ll see it on your left before reaching the Station Inn).
